The viola is a somewhat put-upon instument, being the subject of rude jokes and accusations of inadequacies. I have attempted to lend it my support by writing Music for Solo Viola (1998), Sonata for Viola and Piano (1989) and now Peregrinations for Viola and Orchestra (2002). The new piece, which is being performed for the first time, celebrates the fine playing of Paul Silverthorne, of London, whom I have had the pleasure to know and hear play over the past ten or so years.
